
Community Health Worker Credential

The two departments of SUNY Schenectady County Community College have entered into this agreement of intent to work together to enhance educational and career opportunities in order to promote seamless, non-duplicative instruction that benefit students, and the community at large.

Developed through SUNY Schenectady administrative and instructor course review and collaboration, this Agreement gives college credit towards the Human Services A.A.S or A.S. degree or the Community Health worker certificate for the coursework completed as a Community Health Worker credential under SUNY Schenectady's Workforce Development division.

HUS 221 – Field Experience	3 credit hours
FYS 100 – First Year Experience	1 credit hour

This agreement is effective from September 1, 2017 through September 1, 2020 at which time it will be reviewed by both parties. This agreement is between two departments of SCCC. Courses awarded credit through this agreement are unique to SCCC and there is no assurance that college credit awarded through this agreement will transfer to other postsecondary institution.

APPENDIX A

For a student to obtain college credit for course articulated within this program, the following criteria must be met:

- The student must receive the Community Health Worker Credential
- The student must submit a complete portfolio of hours and projects completed
- Unless waived by the college, the student must complete the course within three (3) years prior to matriculating at SCCC
- The student must meet the College's standards for acceptance and for credit according to the SCCC academic code

Each student meeting the above criteria can be awarded seven credits at SCCC for

SOC 222 – Sociology of the Family	3 credit hours
HUS 221 – Field Experience	3 credit hours
FYS 100 – First Year Experience	1 credit hour
